Semester I Review Project

- Each group of roughly 4 will present a review of a particular topic from the Fall Semester
- Each presentation should be 10 minutes and include the following:
 - 1. A review of the concepts
 - At least 3 common mistakes or misconceptions relevant to the topic and how to avoid them
 - 3. Discuss strategies for tackling free-response questions
 - How do you figure out what an FRQ is asking you to do?
 - Is there any information needed to answer different FRQs that might be *implied* rather than directly stated?
 - In what ways might your topic draw from other units we've covered?
 - Feel free to use examples problems, but remember, I'm not looking for how to solve the problem, I'm looking for how to *think* about the problem
 - 4. Five practice multiple choice questions for the class
 - Optional: use resources such as <u>www.polleverywhere.com</u> to create interactive MC questions
- Everyone in your group must talk
- Presentations will be composed on Power Point, Google Slides, or a similar program, but feel free to use the white board to your advantage
